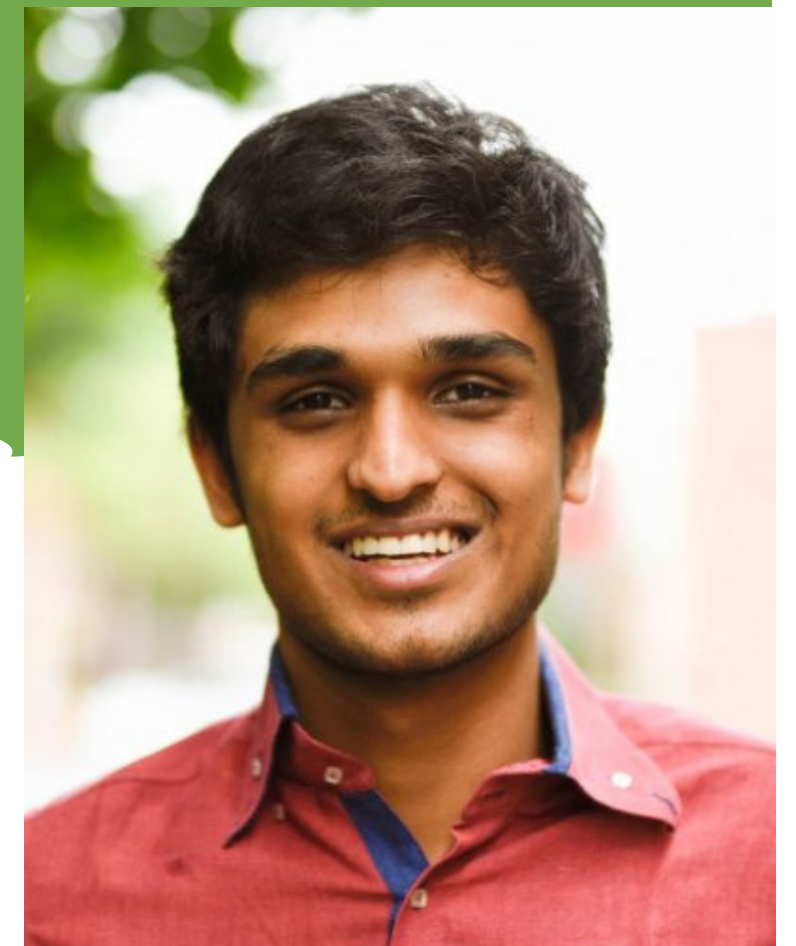


# FORMER PAA TIP OF THE WEEK

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## PREPARING FOR SPRING COURSE SELECTION!

Course selection for spring semester is **HERE!** While the process can be a bit overwhelming and navigating so many course offerings somewhat challenging, here are a few helpful tips to support you through the remainder of this week!

- **Course Selection opens on Mon. December 9th for the class of 2022 and on Weds. December 11th for the class of 2023 both at 7:30am.**
- **SUBMIT your APF form then meet with your faculty advisor** to discuss your interests and approve your courses! If you do not do this, a hold will be placed on your TigerHub and you will not be able to register for courses.
- **Have you finished the online Not Anymore & AlcoholEdu training?** Make sure you do or a hold will be placed preventing you from registering for spring courses!
- **Use recal.io to map out your courses** and **princetoncourses.com** to discover new ones! These tools can be more user-friendly than the Registrar's site!
- **Keep in mind prospective major requirements** and distribution requirements, but don't let this limit you! Explore classes outside of your comfort zone - you may discover a new interest or passion.
- **Have back-up courses!** First-years and sophomores get last pick on courses and some classes may fill up, so it's a good idea to have back-ups as you plan for the semester.
- **Choosing between two departments?** No problem! The best way to decide what department you will like is to try out a few classes. **Parallel planning (taking pre-reqs for two or more majors simultaneously)** also allows you to explore without fully committing to a major.
- **Before course selection add your courses to the queue on TigerHub**, this will help you register for classes as soon as course selection opens **AT 7:30 AM!**
